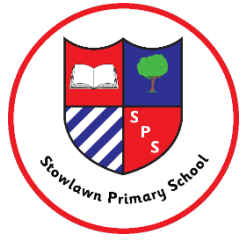
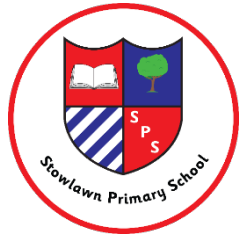


Expectations and attributes



Expectations – how we expect everyone in school to behave so we can “live” together happily

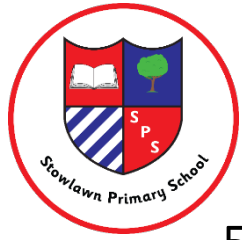
Attributes – a quality you show :
Our “**Stowlawn 6!**”



Expectations :

- Ready
- Respectful
- Safe

- Only 3 simple expectations to remember whenever you choose your behaviours !
- Not only in lessons, but in all situations – moving around school, on the playground , entering and leaving classrooms, in the hall / dining room
- Watch out for new routines such as our “fantastic finish!”



What if I don't show that I can be ready, respectful or safe in the choices I make?

5 steps to change :

Step 1

We will remind you of the expectations, and support you to change your behaviours to follow them

Step 2

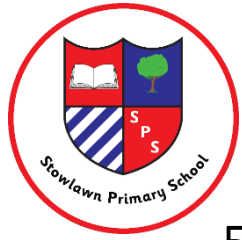
You will receive a clear verbal caution, explaining again the expectations and clearly explaining the next step

Step 3

Following clear instructions on how to change behaviours, and expectations still not being met, you will owe your teacher 5 minutes of the next playtime. This cannot be removed, increased, reduced or changed .

Step 4

Time Out : a short time outside the room / on a thinking chair/spot / side of the field or playground. This is a few minutes for you child to calm down, breathe, look at the situation from a different perspective and calm yourself.



What if I don't show that I can be ready, respectful or safe in the choices I make?

5 steps to change :

Step 5

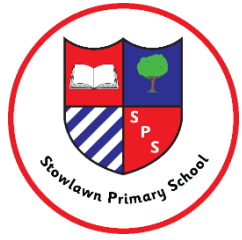
Repair : You are expected to have a conversation with your teacher, looking at your choice of behaviours and who that has effected and why. Also looking at how you can make the correct choices next time.

However

Any behaviours such as :

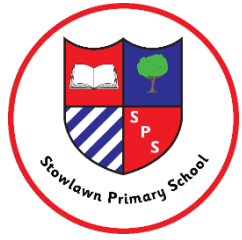
- Violence towards another child or adult
- Verbal aggression towards another child or adult (including racist comments)
- Breaking furniture etc.

Will immediately involve a senior teacher, and decisions made involveing parents at home.

A new reward programme;

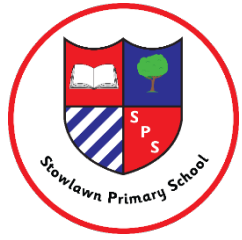
- You will work together to collect your pom poms to fill your class jar.

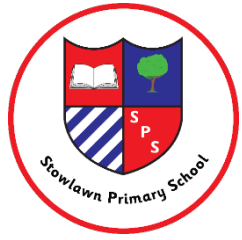


Attributes :

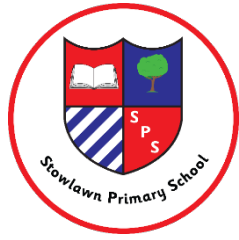
