- Use the pictures to put the nursery rhyme in the right order. Use these when you are singing.

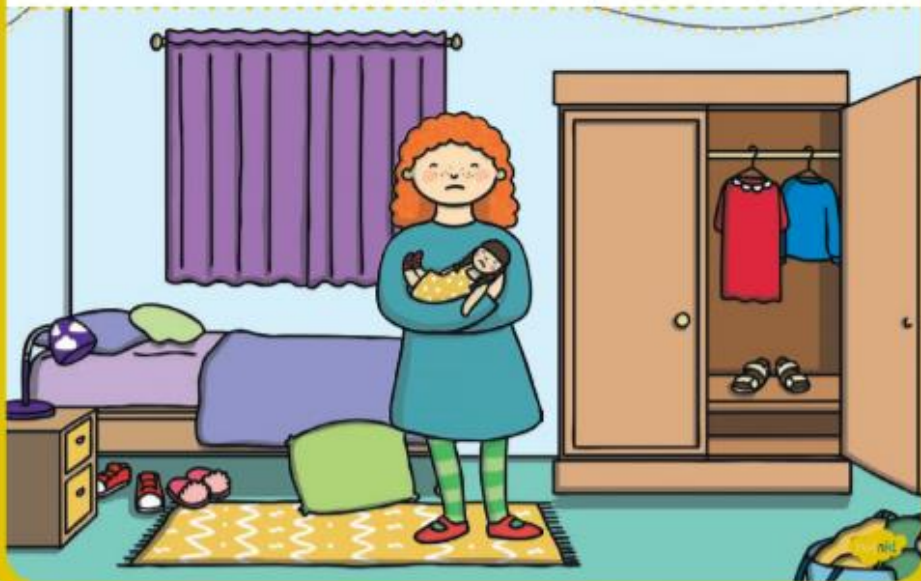
