Maths	Practise times tables on: TTrockstars, Hit the button, multiplication bingo, Tommy's trek. On Purple Mash, play order and compare looking at numbers over 1000. On top marks, click on the link (http://www.ictgames.com/mobilePage/countingCaterpillar/index.html) and play the game counting caterpillar. You have to order the numbers from the smallest to the biggest.
Reading	Log in to your Purple Mash account and go to your '2emails' (If you do not get an alert for this, go to tools- communication and sharing - 2emails. You will receive a comprehension task to complete. Once you have completed the task and written your answers, you can save the file and attach it to the email for us to see OR save it to your work folders.
Writing	Log into your 2emails- Thor was the great Viking god of Thunder. Your task this week is to create your own Viking God. You might want to research some other Viking Gods first using this link... https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zyy9wxs Think of a cool name, tell me what they are the god of, what their powers would be, what they look like and how they would use their powers. You can upload your work back onto the email and send it to us to mark.
Topic	Art - Draw around your hand (ask someone to help you if possible). Once you have completed the outline, fill the hand with patterns and shapes. Colour or paint your design using bright, contrasting colours. You can take photos of your design and use '2email' to send them over 
	Science - On Purple Mash, watch the video about how sound is made and create a leaflet with all the information you have learnt. You need to make sure you include facts and use some of the pictures provided in your leaflet.
History	Use the link to help you learn more about Viking and Saxon beliefs.
