<b>Maths</b>	<p>Look around the kitchen for a variety of food items and discuss the measures on the packets e.g. 350g or 0.5l. Did you find any imperial measures? (for example, pounds = lb, don't convert these!)</p> <p>Next convert the metric measurements e.g. 350g = 0.35kg      0.5l = 500ml.</p>
<b>Reading</b>	<p>At the moment, David Walliams is reading one of his stories at 11o'clock every day! Your task is to listen to it if you can. <a href="https://www.worldofdavidwalliams.com/elevenses/">https://www.worldofdavidwalliams.com/elevenses/</a> If you can't listen to David Walliams, then choose your favourite book and read it (or part of it) to a member of your family.</p>
<b>Writing</b>	<p>Write a diary entry for your first week in 'lock down'. Think about why you couldn't go to school, how you felt about the situation, what you did to occupy the time and what you hope will happen next. Remember to write in a conversational, non-formal way and try to include all the sentence structure features we have discussed at school. (e.g. parenthesis, subordinate clauses, variety of sentence starts).</p>
<b>Topic</b>	<p>Construction/Lego challenge. Create a form of transport to get an astronaut to the moon. You could use lego, junk modelling, a computer app or items found in the garden! Use your imagination, the choice is yours.</p>
<b>Science-</b>	<p>Try the 'Why we wash our hands with soap' investigation. First part-fill a bowl with water. Next, sprinkle pepper into the water. Dip your fingers into the bowl of pepper-water. Try swilling the pepper off with just water. Dip your fingers again but this time wash your hands with soap. What did you notice? Did you wash your hands correctly? Why is it important to wash your hands with soap?</p>
