Maths - Puzzles	Using the numbers 12, 24, 71 Which is the odd one out? Why? Ch 2: Explain why another of the numbers is the odd one out. Ch 3: Explain a reason why all of the numbers could be the odd one out.	Alphabet Numbers: Using any letter only once, what are the largest and smallest numbers that you can write down in words? Example: EIGHTY But not NINETY as N is used twice Ch 2: allow negatives such as MINUS TWO
		Ch 3: allow calculations such as TWO SQUARED
Reading	Using your favourite book, fiction or non-fiction, think of 5 questions you would like to ask one of the characters. Then write their answers as if you were that character. For example Elsie in the Ice Monster or Neil Armstrong in a book about Space.
