

Year 5 Suggested Home Learning Tasks

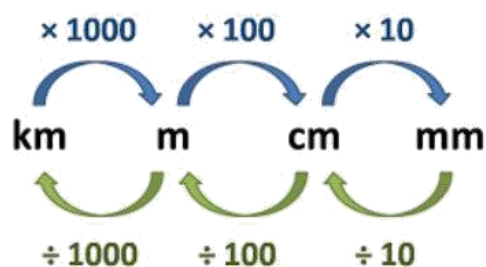

Writing	<p>Write a diary entry based on being in the Amazon Rainforest. For this, I have set a Purple Mash task – it has to include lots of detail and think about the things at the side of your set diary task, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is the weather like? • What might you eat? • Who might be there with you? • What animals or creatures are there? • What might you be doing to try and escape (no gadgets)?
Topic	<p>For our South America topic, I am going to set you a challenge this week! To link our whole week's learning together, it would be brilliant if you could create a piece of music.</p> <p>Imagine you are in the Amazon Rainforest, and are running from a tiger, and there is music playing.
