Maths	<p>Practise times tables on: TTrackstars, Hit the button, multiplication bingo, Tommy's trek. On BBC Bitesize, click on the link (https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zjtg47h) and watch the video to help you understand how to find a fraction of an amount. On Purple Mash, play the fractions equivalence quiz. On Topmarks click on the link (https://phet.colorado.edu/sims/html/fraction-matcher/latest/fraction-matcher_en.html) and play the game called fraction matcher. Click on the tab fractions and it is up to you what level you choose.</p>

Make the poster eye-catching, informative and remember to use pictures.
